



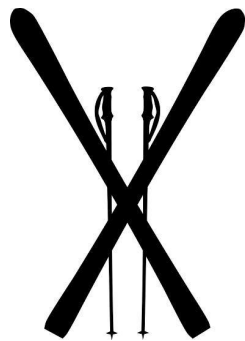

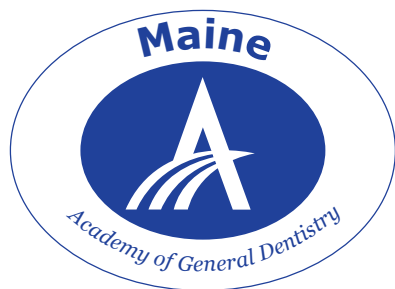

Speaker Bio: After earning his bachelor's degree in psychology from Rutgers College, Dr. Steven Rasner graduated from The University of Pennsylvania in 1980 with a doctorate in dental medicine. He received his Mastership from the Academy of General Dentistry in 1997 and completed the written portion for the Board certification by the American Board of General Dentistry. In 2018 he received his Diplomate from the ICOI. Known for his passion and original, rapid-fire delivery, Dr. Rasner has challenged, inspired, and shared his principles of success with professionals in 44 states and 5 countries. He has received numerous speaking awards around the world, including Best Speaker of the Year in several venues including Australia and Toronto. He has also been chosen as one of the Top 100 Clinical Educators by the dental publication Dentistry Today for the past 12 years.
